Old Business

- When called to accidents, call for fire if they are not initially called.
- Wait for update before committing to the interstate if injuries are not confirmed when paged for calls on the interstate. Sign on and respond to Maplefields and stage until an update is received.
- Approved for Vermont League of Cities and Towns grant. Will be ordering turnout style jackets which are blood borne pathogen resistant as well as helmets and goggles.
- Asking members to pay for half of cost of jumpsuits. Will poll members at June meeting.
- Considered foam style hand sanitizer but decided to order standard alcohol based sanitizer due to cost and convenience.

New Business

- Planning to order extrication gloves which are also blood borne pathogen resistant.
- Be mindful of speed when responding to calls. Remember you are responsible to exercise due regard for public safety.
- Supplies are in. Please check expiration dates for all drugs.
- Training assigned on LearnEMS.
- OB/GYN training hours available on June 8th, 6-9pm at BFA St. Albans.
- EMT testing on July 11th. Will be looking for volunteers.
- Considering new IV catheters. Catheters currently in use offer limited protection regarding sharps control. Looking at retractable safety catheter which will increase level of safety on scene.
- Should be getting information on state EMS conference soon. Will cover entry cost to conference but not the extra specialized sessions. Encouraged to attend.
- New certification requirements for registry. Specific hours will be determined by an assessment. More details to come when released.
