COVID-19 cases are on the rise in our area. Please visit the Center for Disease Control (CDC) website www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/ for updates on COVID-19 protocols as colder weather and more indoor activities bring people together.

- If you have COVID-19, you can spread the virus to others. There are precautions you can take to prevent spreading it to others: isolation, masking, and avoiding contact with people who are at high risk of getting very sick. Isolation is used to separate people with confirmed or suspected COVID-19 from those without COVID-19.
- The Town of Georgia has a limited supply of free COVID-19 test kits. Please stop by the Town Hall to pick one up as needed, while supplies last.
- As of Monday, September 25, the federal government will send up to 4 free COVID-19 tests per household. Visit www.covid.gov/tests to order your tests to be delivered to your home.
- According to the CDC, COVID-19 vaccines are safe, effective and free. Everyone 6 months and older can get an updates COVID-19 vaccine.
