

Town of Georgia Declaration of Inclusion

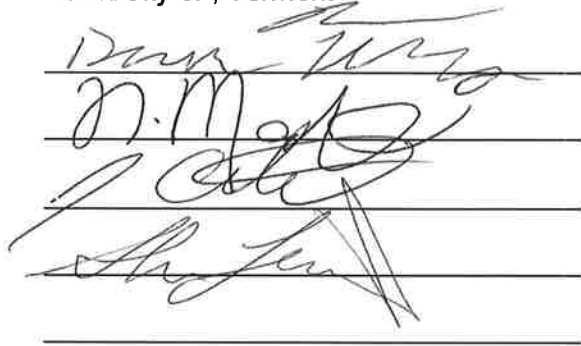
