

# Vital Records

## Overview

Certified copies of birth, marriage, and death certificates are available at the Town Clerk's Office for \$10.00 per certified copy.

## Birth & Death Certificates

Effective July 1, 2019, changes were made to the [rules for obtaining](#) birth and death certificates. More details can be found online at the [Vermont Department of Health](#) website.

To obtain a Birth or Death certificate, you will need to show valid identification and submit an [Application for Vermont Birth or Death Certificate](#). You can complete the application at the Town Clerk's office or prepare it ahead of time.

## Marriage Licenses

**Effective July 1, 2022, if you are getting married in Vermont, you may obtain a marriage license from any Vermont town/city clerk;** there's no longer a requirement for Vermont residents to go to the clerk's office in the town where they reside.

You will need to complete a [Marriage License Application](#) and bring it to the Town Clerk's Office. The marriage license fee is \$80.00, which includes one certified copy of your marriage license. Additional copies are \$10.00 each.
