Danielle presented “A Story Map of Deer Brook” she had walked the brook earlier this year, from the mouth to I89. The brook has been listed as a 303d impaired water since 1996. A TMDL has not been written yet. Further stream sampling is underway. Some erosion was noted on the power cut near the stream.

Kent will contact them about a possible ROW from Rt.104, on the St. Albans South town line. The law firm agreed to update the deeds to include the 1917 ROW for no additional fees. Kent is working on setting up a meeting with John Gallagher.
