Old Business

- Minutes of the previous meeting read by the secretary. Motion to accept made by Jamie Cota seconded by Randy Eppley, motion passed.
- New truck has been delivered. Planning to have truck in service by March 18th. Garth Brooks will be conducting a training on the new truck tonight. Wireless headsets in the front of the truck, wired in the back. Will be using Cold Fire foam on the new truck.

- Town budget was approved. The fire department budget increased slightly and the corrosion work on Engine 2 and a refurb of the Brush truck was also approved.
- Get Calcutta tickets in soon to ensure they are all sold. Will also be selling paver bricks for \$125 each for firefighter names only.
- Sending around a couple cards to be signed and sent to departments with recent line of duty deaths.

- The 21st will be training related to the new truck and the 28th will be our annual CPR refresher.

appointed to Captain, Michael Baker will remain 1st Lieutenant, and Jeff Bryant has been appointed to 2nd Lieutenant. Positions may be effective as of Tuesday morning pending approval by the Select Board on Monday night.
