**Old Business**

- There was no update on the budget.
- The district QA/QI had a good discussion on seizures. Covered types of seizures, atypical presentations and tendency of responders to be complacent. There will be no QA/QI in July. The next QA/QI will be in August on behavior emergencies.
- Fairfax Rescue is hosting an EMR class in September.
- MVR is hosting an EMR/EMT course in September.
- An AEMT class is tentatively scheduled for August.
- There is a PHTLS course being offered in Swanton on July 13<sup>th</sup>/14<sup>th</sup>. Cost is \$250.
- District 1 test is tentatively scheduled for July, however a date has not been confirmed.
- Chelsea will send an update training schedule.

- Next two weeks will be extrication training for the Fire Department. The first week will be rescue jacks and the following week will be extrication. First Response is welcome to attend.

- Recertifications are due to the state by the end of the month for those recertifying in June.

- Next meeting is planned for July 15<sup>th</sup>. Training will be on trauma assessment and will begin at 6:00pm with the meeting to follow at 7:00pm.
