On-going business:

RGNA: Ken sent Todd a note thanking him about taking down a tree leaning on the fence and removing dumped tires.

Silver Lake Woods:

CL4 portion of Silver Lake Rd. The Commission is recommending removal of the culvert establishing a ford retaining the CL4 status. Reference E-mails from: Chris Brunelle, Todd Eaton and Lee Simard (Vermont ANR) Suz and Peter will obtain estimates for the culvert removal and crushed stone fill for the road. Peter will draft up a work scope.

Ken checked with Chris Brunelle: 1. Armoring the upstream bend
2. Re-contouring the banks 3. Installing a skidder bridge. NO response.

Sign status: Sign delivery has been delayed.

Trail marking: Suz applied for a Tiny grant

Trail Mowing: Can the town make a couple of passes this summer?

Chris will try to remove rotted culvert on the parcel several hundred yards from the property border

Signage: Ken will work on a small sign outlining uses of the parcel.

New Business:

2. Scholarship: No applicants
3. Green-Up: Delayed till May 30th. NWSWD is on board, bags have been distributed, and the town crew will pick up bags from the roadside.
