Old Business

- Everyone should have their ID badges. At least one badge is being remade due to an error.
- The Centrelearn courses for the new protocols have been assigned. Please do the assignments by the end of the month as we would like to go live with the new protocols on July 1st. Some changes to the state protocols may be made at the district level.
- Discussed patient refusals. Previously we have relied solely on the transport agency to document patient refusals. We will start carrying patient refusal forms; however, the preference will continue to be to have the transport agency document patient refusals.

New Business

- The town has created a mutual agency support memorandum of understanding allowing town employees to respond to emergencies during work hours or at times which may delay their reporting to work provided they follow the guidance in the policy. There is also a town COVID-19 policy.
- The bridge on 104A which is currently reduced to one lane will be closed beginning July 15th.
- The suggestion has been made to put trash bags in jump bags for disposing of lightly contaminated PPE or equipment that does not need to be red bagged but should be isolated before disposal or decontamination.
- Some training equipment has been donated to us by Essex Rescue.
- Fairfax Rescue will be doing a high-performance CPR class and a pediatric high-performance CPR class. Let Andrew know if you have not taken the class or wish to take it in Fairfax.
