

PUBLIC NOTICE

In accordance with the provisions of 19 VSA Sections 1971-1976, The Georgia Selectboard hereby takes the following action. At a duly warned Selectboard meeting, on April 13th, the Board rescinded a portion of an Ordinance relating to weigh limits on Town Roads. The specific section rescinded is Section I. (F) Load Limits, from an Ordinance adopted on November 5th, 1986. The exact text of Section (F) is as follows:

“These load limits are in effect on all roads except as specified below:

2 axle vehicles.....	36,000 lbs
3 axle vehicles.....	55,000 lbs
5 axle vehicles.....	72,000 lbs

Georgia Mountain Rd #36, maximum weight 40,000 lbs.”

The full text of this ordinance may be viewed at the Town Clerk’s Office during working hours. Questions regarding this action may be referred to the Town Administrator, Duncan Hastings at 524-9794. At least five percent of the legal voters of the Town of Georgia may, within 44 days of this action by the Board, petition for a full Town vote, to approve or disapprove of this action by the Board. If such a petition is received, the Selectboard must warn a Town Meeting within 60 days.

Henceforth, load limits shall be established and regulated according to the provisions of 23 VSA ch. 13. Weight limit permits shall be obtained from the Georgia Selectboard for all vehicles using Town Roads, in excess is 24,000 lbs. Permits may be obtained through the Town Clerk’s of Town Administrator’s Office. Truckers shall supply proof of insurance and their State Permit number.
