### **Old Business**

- Andrew requested a purchase order for the work to install key fob access to the office. He has not yet received confirmation.
- Pagers were reprogrammed tonight.
- Remember to use the dispatch issued CAD number for the incident number on Siren reports. Use the whole CAD code. There is a response number which will auto-increment which does not need to be changed.

### **New Business**

- Ed Simon has applied to join First Response. He is a newly certified EMT who is also affiliated with Essex Rescue. He lives on Georgia Mountain Road. Craig made a motion to accept his application, Chelsea Dubie seconded, motion passed.
- Andrew has Calcutta tickets to be distributed for sale. They are \$125 and include dinner for two. See Andrew if you wish to purchase one or know someone who does. It is March 28<sup>th</sup> at the American Legion in St. Albans. Cocktail hour at 5:00pm, dinner at 6:00pm, and the drawing to follow dinner.
- There is a new question in Siren. The question asks whether any responders were paid by the Fire Department.
- There will be an infection control training with the Fire Department next month on the 20<sup>th</sup>.
- There will be a training on pediatric transport and obstetric emergencies on March 16<sup>th</sup> starting at 6:30pm at the fire station.
- Chelsea is working on setting up a hemorrhage control training in May and June, however dates have not been set.
- The resuscitation academy was canceled due to inclement weather. Currently looking at February 22<sup>nd</sup> or 23<sup>rd</sup>.
- There is an AEMT class beginning February 11<sup>th</sup> in Fairfax.
- The Art Carrol scholarship is \$500, and the application process requires applicants to write an essay to be reviewed and voted upon by members.
- Recertifications are due by March 31<sup>st</sup>. Include the trainer and contact information in documentation for any outside trainings.
- Chelsea distributed Narcan to EMTs.

- The next district meeting is on February 12<sup>th</sup> at 6:00pm. They will be reviewing a preterm delivery and pediatric arrest call.
