**1. Silver Lake Woods:**

## **2. Lost Pond Parcel:**

Ken & Kent met with John Gallagher, regarding a ROW from Rt. 104. He was generally accepting of the concept. He requested we send the file to his lawyer for comment. No new news. The proposed ROW is wet at the West end. A boardwalk would be required. Parking on 104 is also an issue. Ken requested other members to evaluate the path.
